## Working group Water, Greenery, and Biodiversity

In accordance with the <u>strategic materials</u> of Charles University for sustainable development, **expert working groups** (WG) were established for key areas of <u>Administration and Operations</u>. For the purpose of work efficiency and overlapping of sustainability topics, some key areas of Administration and Operations were merged into one WG (<u>Energy and Construction</u>, <u>Waste and Food services</u>). Thanks to the system of <u>SD Coordinators</u> and their partial involvement, the different WGs share the necessary information, thus ensuring transparency and efficiency in achieving common goals.

The WGs operate in a "Guarantor - Co-facilitator - Member" system, which proved its worth in the University Leaders in SDGs projects ( <u>UNILEAD I and II</u> ), which brought together 25 Czech public universities and operated from 2022-2023.

Water, greenery and biodiversity WG deals primarily with mapping greenspaces under CU management and their use to support biodiversity.
