The Sustainable Development Goals are conceived at a global level, and Charles University is aware of this scope and its role in it. Active involvement in international initiatives, the **exchange of know-how**, and examples of good practice in the field of sustainable development and **strengthening of international relations** are among the key activities of the university on its path to sustainability.

In the area of science and research, CU participates in **international research projects** funded by the European Union and other organizations. It is a founding member of the [4EU+ Alliance](#) , which focuses on sustainable development and climate change, and actively participates in projects related to the UN Sustainable Development Goals. Other partner projects include [RCE Czechia](#) , [UNICA Green](#) , and the [Copernicus Alliance](#) .

As part of international student exchanges, the university offers **study programmes and courses on sustainable development** in English and regularly organizes international conferences, seminars, and workshops. In this way, the university contributes to addressing global challenges through research, education, and cooperation with international partners.
